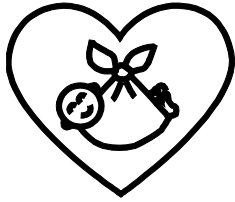

Application Fee	\$300	Paid upon submission	Clerical assistance
Embryo Home Study *If required by clinic/agency	\$1600	Paid prior to attendance	For presenters, materials, in office visits and one home visit.
Personal meeting between donor and recipient family	\$100	Paid at meeting	Facilitating meeting
Post birth Supervisory Report *If required by clinic/agency	\$300/each	After successful birth of a child	Visiting family and writing report
